8 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**

9 Respondent is hereby notified of the right to petition for a rehearing or review by
10 filing a petition with the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service
11 of this Order. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09. The petition must set forth legally sufficient reasons
12 for granting a rehearing. A.C.C. R4-23-128. Service of this order is effective five (5)
13 days after date of mailing. If a motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order
14 becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

17 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required
18 to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
