FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS
of LAW and BOARD ORDER
No. 14-0016-PHR

10 Pursuant to Notice of Hearing Number 14-0016-PHR (Notice) this matter came
11 before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy (Board) on December 10, 2014.

13 Jim Foy, Pharm D, president, presided with members Tom Van Hassel, Bill
14 Francis, Darren Kennedy, Kyra Locnikar, Dennis McAllister, Reuben Minkus, John
15 Musil, and Nona Rosas in attendance.

17 The State was represented by the Office of the Attorney General, Monty Lee,
18 Assistant Attorney General, Licensing and Enforcement Section. Brittany Leon,
19 (Respondent) was not present and was not represented by an attorney. Christopher
20 Munns, Assistant Solicitor General, was available to provide independent legal advice to
21 the Board if necessary. The Board granted the State's motion to deem the allegations in
22 the Complaint to be admitted. Based upon A.R.S. § 32-1927.01(O) and the Complaint
23 and Notice of Hearing No. 14-0016-PHR filed in this matter, the Board issues the
24 following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and Order revoking Respondent's
25 license.
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1 **ORDER**

2 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board issues
3 the following Order: The pharmacy technician license issued to BRITTANY LEON is
4 hereby **REVOKED**.

6 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**

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8 Respondent is hereby notified of the right to petition for a rehearing or review by
9 filing a petition with the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service
10 of this Order. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09. The petition must set forth legally sufficient reasons
11 for granting a rehearing. A.C.C. R4-23-128. Service of this order is effective five (5)
12 days after date of mailing. If a motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order
13 becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

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16 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required
17 to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
