John Musil was unable to attend the meeting.

Mr. Blaire opened the discussion by stating that the committee should develop guidelines for the Compliance staff so that they are able to conduct inspections of these pharmacies compounding products under USP 800.

Mr. Van Hassel discussed the various aspects of USP 800.

Mr. Blaire indicated that the scope of USP 800 goes beyond the scope of the Board of Pharmacy. Mr. Blaire indicated that USP 800 would include wholesalers and practitioners.

Dr. Gandhi stated that the Board does not have authority to regulate practitioners.

Mr. Van Hassel suggested that the Board could send information about USP 800 to the practitioners.

Mr. Blaire indicated that the committee should expand the scope to include USP 797 and 800.

Dr. Gandhi asked if the Board could just adopt USP 797 and USP 800.

Mr. Van Hassel stated that the committee could carve out certain areas of USP 797 and USP 800 because not everyone would be able to meet all the requirements.

Ms. Galvin suggested that the committee could add individuals with an interest in the compounding, such as nuclear medicine specialists.

Mr. Blaire adjourned the meeting at 10:30 A.M.
