8 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence and records compiled and
9 contained in the file for KERMIT THOMPSON and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 18th day
10 of June, 2003 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board Order in the Matter
11 of 03-0005-PHR.

12 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

13 **I**

14 1. KERMIT THOMPSON is the holder of Pharmacist License Number 4314 issued by the Arizona
15 State Board of Pharmacy which permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

16 2. That on the 5th day of June, 2003 KERMIT THOMPSON entered into a Consent to Entry of
17 Order with the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the Notice
18 of Hearing number 03-0005-PHR are true and accurate.

19 3. That KERMIT THOMPSON admits to violations of A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10), and A.R.S. §
20 32-1927(B)(2) to wit:

21 32-1927(A)(10) The licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of violating any Arizona or
22 federal law, rule or regulation relating to the manufacture and distribution of drugs, and devices
or the practice of pharmacy.

23 32-1927(B)(2) The licensee is found by the board, or is convicted in a federal or state court, of
24 having violated federal or state laws or administrative rules pertaining to marijuana, prescription-
only drugs, narcotics, dangerous drugs or controlled substances.

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 **II**

3 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-
4 1927(A)(10) and A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

5 2. The Board concludes that KERMIT THOMPSON violated A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10), and
6 A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

7 **ORDER**

8 **III**

9 The Pharmacist License Number 4314 issued to KERMIT THOMPSON is hereby placed on
10 PROBATION for a period of one (1) year commencing ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The
11 probation is subject to the following conditions:

12 1. KERMIT THOMPSON shall pay a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the
13 Board for failing to verify the directions on the prescription dispensed on December 11, 2002 as
14 listed in the Notice within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order.

15 2. KERMIT THOMPSON shall obey all federal and state laws and rules governing the practice
16 of pharmacy.

17 3. KERMIT THOMPSON shall provide evidence to Board staff of successful completion of
18 the Continuing Education course offered by the Arizona Pharmacy Association titled "How to
19 Effectively Resolve a Medication Error" before the end of the probation period.


20 4. If KERMIT THOMPSON violates this Order in any way or fails to fulfill the requirements
21 of this Order, the Board, after giving the Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may
22 revoke, suspend or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent. The issue at such hearing
23 will be limited solely to whether this Board Order has been violated.

24 5. KERMIT THOMPSON shall appear before the Board at a regularly scheduled Board
25 meeting on or after June 19, 2004, to request termination of the probation.
