**ADDENDUM TO CONSENT  
AGREEMENT REINSTATING  
PHARMACIST LICENSE WITH  
PROBATION**

15 The Arizona State Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) and James J. Green (“Mr.  
16 Green”) hereby enter into this Addendum to the Consent Agreement Reinstating  
17 Pharmacist License with Probation with regard to Board Case No. 08-0012-PHR signed  
18 by Mr. Green on October 5, 2007, and effective October 9, 2007 (“Consent Agreement”).

19 At the Board’s March 2008 Board Meeting, Mr. Green requested that the Board  
20 change the requirement in the Consent Agreement that Mr. Green may work only in the  
21 presence and under the immediate supervision of another pharmacist. In response to Mr.  
22 Green’s request, Mr. Green and the Board hereby amend the Consent Agreement as set  
23 forth in this Addendum.

1 Mr. Green's reinstated license is immediately placed on  
2 PROBATION for a period of six (6) months from the effective date  
3 of this Addendum to the Consent Agreement. During the term of  
4 probation, Mr. Green shall complete the following terms and  
5 conditions:

6 a. If Mr. Green obtains employment as a pharmacist in the  
7 six months following the effective date of this Addendum to the  
8 Consent Agreement, Mr. Green shall immediately inform the  
9 Board's executive director. Upon obtaining employment as a  
10 pharmacist, Mr. Green shall ensure that his supervisor submits  
11 monthly reports detailing Mr. Green's work performance to the  
12 Board. The reports shall be due in the Board's office on the 15<sup>th</sup> day  
13 of the first month following the start of Mr. Green's employment  
14 and the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month thereafter for six (6) months  
15 following the effective date of this Addendum to the Consent  
16 Agreement. It is the Mr. Green's responsibility to ensure that his  
17 supervisor submits his/her reports monthly. If the monthly reporting  
18 date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, the report is due on the  
19 next business day. The monthly report may be filed by mail or  
20 facsimile.


21 b. If a monthly report submitted by Mr. Green's supervisor  
22 negatively describes Mr. Green's work performance, Mr. Green  
23 shall be required to appear before the Board.

24 c. Mr. Green shall appear before the Board at a regularly  
25 scheduled Board meeting six (6) months from the effective date of  
26 this Consent Agreement to request that his probation be terminated.  
Mr. Green's failure to petition the Board to terminate the probation  
shall extend the probation period.

All other provisions of the Consent Agreement remain in full force and effect.
