

1 FINDINGS OF FACT

2 1. During all relevant times to these findings, Respondent worked as a pharmacy
3 intern at Food City Pharmacy #154 located at 9020 W. Thomas Rd., Phoenix, Arizona (the
4 “Pharmacy”).

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6 2. On or about February 19, 2013 Respondent was observed on a video camera
7 surveillance tape recording engaging in activity consistent with stealing Cialis 5 mg. from the
8 Pharmacy stock shelves.

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10 3. On or about February 21, 2013 Respondent was observed on a video camera
11 surveillance tape recording engaging in activity consistent with stealing Cialis 20 mg. from the
12 Pharmacy stock shelves.

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14 4. On February 22, 2013 Respondent was interviewed by Basha’s Pharmacy
15 personnel at the Pharmacy regarding his activities on February 19 and 21, 2013 as well as an
16 on-going investigation into missing medications from the Pharmacy over the past month.
17 Respondent initially denied any wrong doing but later admitted that he was responsible for the
18 missing quantities of Cialis 5mg. and Cialis 20mg.

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21 5. Respondent was terminated from his employment with the Pharmacy for
22 violation of company policy stemming from his theft of these drugs.

23 CONCLUSIONS of LAW

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25 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter and over Respondent
26 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1901 *et seq.*


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28 2. The Board may discipline a pharmacy intern who has engaged in unprofessional
29 conduct. A.R.S. § 32-1927(A) (1).

1 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required to
2 preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
