3 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**


4 Respondent is hereby notified of the right to petition for a rehearing or review by filing
5 a petition with the Board's Executive Director within thirty (30) days after service of this
6 Order. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09. The petition must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting
7 a rehearing. A.C.C. R4-23-128. Service of this order is effective five (5) days after date of
8 mailing. If a motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective thirty-five
9 (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

11 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required to
12 preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
