9 This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing  
10 on the 14th day of October, 1986, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of hearing  
11 No. 86-5-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and made a  
12 part of this order. Al Brooks, president, presided, with Daniel Jacob, vice  
13 president, and members Paula Bickett, Simon Eisenberg, Betinna Lopez, Norma  
14 McConnell, and Adaline Pangrazi in attendance and participating therein.

15 The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General,  
16 John Kelly, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent, FRANCIS E. BAGWELL  
17 was not present and was not represented by counsel.

18 The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented,  
19 hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

20 FINDINGS OF FACT

21 I

22 FRANCIS E. BAGWELL is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration  
23 No. 7792 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

24 II

25 Sufficient evidence was presented to substantiate the charges contained in  
26 paragraphs V, VI and VII of the complaint.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

III

That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient evidence to find that FRANCIS E. BAGWELL is in violation of those state and federal laws, rules and regulations in charges contained in paragraphs V. VI and VII of the complaint.

IV

The above described violations constitute grounds for discipline pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927.

ORDER

V

In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board hereby issues the following Order:

That the Certificate of Registration No. 7924 issued to FRANCIS E. BAGWELL be revoked for a period of ninety-nine (99) years, effective October 14, 1986.

FRANCIS E. BAGWELL is hereby notified he has the right to petition this Board for a rehearing within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R4-23-109.
