This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing on the 21st day of June, 1988, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of Hearing No. 88-3-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), Daniel Jacob, president of the Board, presided, with Norma McConnell, vice president, and members Sumner "Al" Brooks, Michael Noel, Edward Saba and Martha Barron in attendance and participating therein.

The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Montgomery Lee, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent, MARTIN D. JACOBS, was not present and was not represented by counsel. Evidence of sufficient and proper notice to the Respondent was presented.

The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

MARTIN D. JACOBS is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration No. 5785 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

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II

Sufficient evidence was presented, including testimony by the Deputy Director of the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy, Joe J. Rowan, to sustain charges contained in the Complaint, specifically that MARTIN D. JACOBS has failed to provide the Board with monthly reports validating Findings that no illegal drugs were present in his system.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

III

That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient evidence to find that MARTIN D. JACOBS is in violation of the Board Order 87-8-H dated December 18, 1987 as contained in paragraph IV, of the Complaint.

IV

The above described violations constitute grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Order 87-8-H, Item 8, dated December 18, 1987.

ORDER

V

In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board hereby issues the following Order:

1. That the Certificate of Registration No. 5785 issued to MARTIN D. JACOBS be revoked effective June 21, 1988.

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MARTIN D. JACOBS is hereby notified that he has the right to petition this Board for a rehearing within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R4-23-109.
