9 This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing  
10 on the 28th day of September, 1988, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of  
11 Hearing No. 88-9-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and  
12 made part of this Order. Norma McConnell, president, presided with members  
13 Danny Jacob, Sumner "Al" Brooks, Edward Saba, Linda Tansik and Martha Barron  
14 in attendance and participating therein.

15 The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Montgomery  
16 Lee, Assistant Attorney General. The Respondent NICHOLAS ARMAND D'ANDREA was  
17 not present and was not represented by counsel.

18 The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented,  
19 hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

21 FINDINGS OF FACT

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23 NICHOLAS ARMAND D'ANDREA is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration  
24 No. 4902 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

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II

Evidence was presented, including a Letter of Testimony dated September 14, 1988, signed by NICHOLAS ARMAND D'ANDREA and notarized on that same date by David R. Hacker. Oral testimony was presented by Llyn A. Lloyd, Executive Director of the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

III

That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient evidence to find that the Certificate of Registration 051-025829 issued to NICHOLAS ARMAND D'ANDREA by the State of Illinois was Suspended for a minimum period of four (4) years in accordance with stipulation and recommendation agreed to by the Illinois State Board of Pharmacy, Controlled Substance Officer and the Respondent as contained in Paragraph IV of the Complaint.

The above described actions constitute grounds for discipline pursuant to ARS § 32-1927.A.
