11 Respondent, to amend the Order in the matter of 91-02-H by vacating
12 the probation imposed in paragraph III on page two (2). Gerald Ritt
13 president presided, with Charles Cordell vice-president and members
14 Daniel Jacob, Michael Noel, Eugene Drake, Natalie Spencer and Dennis
15 McAllister in attendance and participating in discussion therein.

16 The Board heard testimony on the Respondent's compliance with
17 Board Order 91-02-H including compliance with the Pharmacists
18 Assisting Pharmacists of Arizona (PAPA) contract. All of the
19 conditions imposed in the matter of 92-01-H have been met including
20 payment of a civil penalty. After deliberation on the testimony
21 presented the Board unanimously agreed to amend the Order by removing
22 the probation imposed in paragraph III on page two (2). All of the
23 requirements of the Order have been satisfied.
