7 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the
 8 evidence and records compiled and contained in the file for
 9 JULIE ANN CAMP and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 22nd
 10 day of September, 1994 enters the following Finding of Fact,
 11 Conclusions of Law and Board Order in the Matter of 94-04-H.

FINDINGS OF FACT

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 14 1. JULIE ANN CAMP is the holder of Certificate of Registration
 15 Number 6019 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which
 16 permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

17 2. That on the 17th day of August, 1994 JULIE ANN CAMP did
 18 enter into a Consent to Entry of Order with the Arizona State Board
 19 of Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the
 20 Notice of Hearing Number 94-04-H are true and accurate.

21 3. That JULIE ANN CAMP admits to violations of A.R.S. § 36-
 22 2525.B and A.R.S. § 36-2525.D as well as 21 C.F.R. § 1306.11 and 21
 23 § 1306.21 to wit: the possession of and removal of CII and CIII
 24 Controlled Substances from the Desert Samaritan Hospital pharmacy
 25 without a legitimate medical need and without a valid prescription
 26 order and for personal use.

1 stayed and continuing to at least September 22nd, 1999. Further if
2 granted said probation would be subject to the following conditions:

3 1. JULIE ANN CAMP shall have initiated a five (5) year
4 contract with the Pharmacists Assisting Pharmacists of Arizona and
5 comply with each and every requirement of that contract.

6 2. JULIE ANN CAMP shall submit to a minimum of forty-eight
7 annual random biological fluid screenings for the presence of drugs
8 in the system as determined by the Pharmacists Assisting Pharmacists
9 of Arizona program for the period of suspension and the first
10 twenty-four (24) months of the probation period.

11 3. JULIE ANN CAMP shall not serve as a preceptor pharmacist
12 nor as a pharmacist in charge throughout the term of probation.

13 4. JULIE ANN CAMP shall take and successfully complete the
14 Arizona Jurisprudence Examination (AZPLEX) with a score of 90% or
15 better within 120 days of the date of this Order.

16 5. JULIE ANN CAMP shall furnish the Arizona State Board of
17 Pharmacy with a list of all jurisdictions in which she maintains or
18 has maintained licensure in the profession of pharmacy along with
19 the registration number of said licenses.

20 6. JULIE ANN CAMP is required to advise the Arizona State
21 Board of Pharmacy immediately of any change in pharmacy employment
22 status throughout the term of probation.

23 7. JULIE ANN CAMP is required to furnish any and all pharmacy
24 employers with a copy of this Board Order throughout the term of
25 probation.

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1 8. JULIE ANN CAMP shall pay all fees and complete all
2 Continuing Education requirements to maintain certificate of
3 registration number 6019 throughout the term of probation.

4 9. JULIE ANN CAMP shall obey all federal and state laws and
5 rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

6 10. JULIE ANN CAMP shall bear the responsibility for the
7 release of information forms and reports required by this Order.

8 11. JULIE ANN CAMP shall bear all costs for testing,
9 rehabilitation, aftercare programs and reports to be filed.

10 12. JULIE ANN CAMP is required to perform 400 hours of
11 community service in a Board approved program during the time of
12 probation in lieu of a civil penalty in this matter and shall
13 further submit evidence of those hours to the Arizona State Board of
14 Pharmacy prior to September 22, 1999.

15 13. JULIE ANN CAMP shall "hold harmless" the provider of any
16 required reports to the Board of Pharmacy.

17 14. JULIE ANN CAMP shall appear before the Arizona State Board
18 of Pharmacy on or after September 22, 1999, then and there to show
19 cause why the probation imposed by this Order should be vacated.

20 15. If JULIE ANN CAMP violates this Order in any way or fails
21 to fullfill the requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving
22 the Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may revoke,
23 suspend or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.


