FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS  
OF LAW AND BOARD ORDER

This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy on the 1st day of December, 1994 pursuant to Complaint and Notice of Hearing Number 94-13-H ( herinafter referred to as "Complaint" ). Perry D. Don, president, presided with Gerald Ritt, vice-president and members Linda Tansik, Michael Noel, Daniel Jacob and Charles Cordell in attendance and participating therein.

The State was represented by the Office of the Attorney General, Bridget Harrington, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent BRUCE WOOD was not present and was not represented by counsel.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

1. BRUCE WOOD, dba AZTEC PHARMACY is the holder of pharmacy permit Number 2597 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which permits the holder to operate a pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

2. That the evidence and testimony presented in this Matter did sustain the allegations in Paragraphs one (1) through five (5)

of the Complaint, to wit:

1 1. BRUCE WOOD was present in the pharmacy without a licensed  
2 pharmacist present, in violation of A.A.C. R4-23-610 C & D.

3 2. On or about October 7, 1994 there was no evidence of any of  
4 the equipment required to operate a pharmacy in the State of  
5 Arizona, at Aztec Pharmacy, 1829 S. Horne, #4, Mesa, Arizona  
6 in violation of A.A.C. R4-23-612.

7 3. Between the dates of July 11, 1994 and October 7, 1994 no  
8 prescriptions were filled at Aztec Pharmacy, 1829 S. Horne, #4,  
9 Mesa, Arizona.

10 4. Between the dates of July 11, 1994 and October 7, 1994  
11 numerous purchases of prescription drugs were made by BRUCE WOOD dba  
12 Aztec Pharmacy, permit number 2597, at 1829 S. Horne, #4, Mesa,  
13 Arizona, without a Wholesale drug permit as required by A.A.C. R4-23-  
14 605.A.1.

15 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

16 II

17 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter  
18 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1932 (A).

19 2. The Board concludes that BRUCE WOOD did violate A.A.C.  
20 R4-23-610 C & D to wit: he was present in a pharmacy without a  
21 licensed pharmacist present.

22 3. The Board concludes that BRUCE WOOD did violate A.A.C.  
23 R4-23-612 to wit: required equipment used in the practice of  
24 pharmacy was not in evidence at the pharmacy.

25 4. The Board concludes that no prescriptions were filled at  
26 this pharmacy between July 11, 1994 and October 7, 1994.

5. The Board further concludes that BRUCE WOOD did violate

1 A.A.C. R4-23-605 A.1 to wit: "Wholesale distribution" as defined in  
2 A.A.C. R4-23-110 EE and FF was being conducted without a Drug  
3 wholesaler permit issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy.

4 ORDER

5 III

6 The Pharmacy permit Number 2597 issued to BRUCE WOOD dba AZTEC  
7 PHARMACY is hereby revoked, effective 10 days from the date of this  
8 Order.

9 BRUCE WOOD, dba AZTEC PHARMACY is hereby notified that he has  
10 the right to petition this Board for a rehearing within ten (10)  
11 days after receipt of this Order pursuant to the provisions of  
12 A.A.C. R4-23-109.


