10 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence
11 and records compiled and contained in the file for CHARLES COLLINS and
12 for good cause appearing, the Board on this 12th day of March, 1998
13 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board
14 Order in the Matter of 97-0026-PHR.

14 FINDINGS OF FACT

15 I

16 1. CHARLES COLLINS is the holder of Certificate of Registration
17 Number 4187 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which
18 permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

19 2. CHARLES COLLINS was employed as a pharmacist AT OSCO pharmacy
20 #2326 from at least June 1, 1997 to the present.

21 2. That on the 22nd day of January, 1998 CHARLES COLLINS did
22 enter into a Consent to Entry of Order with the Arizona State Board of
23 Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the Notice of
24 Hearing Number 97-0026-PHR are true and accurate.

25 3. That CHARLES COLLINS admits to violations of A.R.S. §
26 32-1927(A)(10), A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2) and A.A.C. § R4-23-407 (A)(7)

1 to wit:

2 (A) The following professional practices in directly dispensing
3 a prescription medication from a prescription order shall be
4 performed by a pharmacist or a pharmacy intern under the
5 supervision of a pharmacist:

(7) checking the label to see that it communicates the
prescriber's directions precisely.

6 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter
9 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10) and A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

10 2. The Board concludes that CHARLES COLLINS did violate A.R.S.
11 § 32-1927(A)(10), A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2) and A.A.C. §§ R4-23-
12 402(A)(7).

13 ORDER

14 III

15 The certificate of Registration Number 4187 issued to CHARLES
16 COLLINS is hereby placed on probation for a period of one (1) year
17 commencing ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The probation is
18 subject to the following conditions:

19 1. CHARLES COLLINS shall pay a civil penalty of three hundred
20 dollars (\$300.00) to the Board of Pharmacy within sixty (60) days of
21 the date of this Order.

22 2. CHARLES COLLINS shall take the AZPLEX examination and pass
23 with a score of at least 90% within 60 days of the date of this Order.

24 3. CHARLES COLLINS shall pay all fees and complete all Continuing
25 Education requirements throughout the term of probation to maintain
26 Certificate of Registration Number 4187.

1 4. CHARLES COLLINS shall obey all federal and state laws and
2 rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

3 5. CHARLES COLLINS may appear before the Arizona State Board of
4 Pharmacy on or after January 15th, 1999 to request termination of the
5 probation after completion of the conditions outlined above.

6 6. If CHARLES COLLINS violates this Order in any way or fails to
7 fulfill the requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving the
8 Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may revoke, suspend
9 or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.
