10 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence and records compiled and
11 contained in the file for DANIEL F. COX and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 9th day of
12 September, 1999 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board Order in the Matter
13 of 99-0021-PHR.

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 **I**

16 1. DANIEL F. COX is the holder of Certificate of Registration Number 11806 issued by the
17 Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

18 2. That on the 5th day of August, 1999, DANIEL F. COX did enter into a Consent to Entry of
19 Order with the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the Notice
20 of Hearing Number 99-0021-PHR are true and accurate.

21 3. That DANIEL F. COX admits to violations of A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10), and A.R.S. § 32-
22 1927(B)(2) to wit:

23 (A)(10) The licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of violating any Arizona or federal law,
24 rule or regulation relating to the manufacture and distribution of drugs, and devices or the practice of
25 pharmacy.

26 (B)(2) The licensee is found by the Board, or is convicted in a federal or state court, of having
violated federal or state laws or administrative rules pertaining to marijuana, prescription only drugs,
narcotics, dangerous drugs or controlled substances

1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10)
4 and A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

5 2. The Board concludes that DANIEL F. COX did violate A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10) and A.R.S.
6 § 32-1927(B)(2).

7 ORDER

8 III

9 The certificate of Registration Number 11806 issued to DANIEL F. COX is hereby placed on
10 probation for two (2) years commencing ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The probation is
11 subject to the following conditions:

12 1. DANIEL F. COX shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) to the Board of
13 Pharmacy within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order.

14 2. DANIEL F. COX shall complete eight (8) hours of Continuing Education within two years of
15 the date of this Order. Said hours shall consist of the two part series (4 hours each) titled Pharmacist-
16 Patient Consultation Program or an alternative program approved by the Board and shall apply only to
17 satisfy this Order and shall not be applied to Continuing Education requirements for subsequent license
18 renewals.

19 3. DANIEL F. COX shall pay all fees and complete all Continuing Education requirements
20 throughout the term of probation to maintain Certificate of Registration Number 11806.

21 4. DANIEL F. COX shall obey all federal and state laws and rules governing the practice of
22 pharmacy.


23 5. The probation shall be automatically terminated upon submission of satisfactory evidence to
24 Board staff of completion of the conditions outlined in paragraphs 1. and 2. above.

25 6. If DANIEL F. COX violates this Order in any way or fails to fulfill the requirements of this
26 Order, the Board, after giving the Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may revoke,

1 suspend or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.
