



## Arizona State Board of Pharmacy

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Due to changes in state law, we are unable to issue licenses\* to those holding an 'Employment Authorization Card' with the following categories:

- A-11 Deferred Enforced Departure
- C-14 Deferred Action
- C-33 Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals

Under Arizona law (A.R.S. §1-501 and §1-502), you must be able to prove legal U.S. residency and by Governor Jan Brewer's executive order 2012-06; we cannot issue, renew or reinstate a license to holders of an Employment Authorization Cards that fall into the above following categories.

This requirement is derived from Title IV of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA). It is defined under United States Code, Title 8, Chapter 14, Subchapter II: Eligibility for State and Local Public Benefits Programs § 1621-1625.

- § 1621. Aliens who are not qualified aliens or nonimmigrants ineligible for State and local public benefits
- § 1622. State authority to limit eligibility of qualified aliens for State public benefits
- § 1623. Limitation on eligibility for preferential treatment of aliens not lawfully present on basis of residence for higher education benefits
- § 1624. Authority of States and political subdivisions of States to limit assistance to aliens and to distinguish among classes of aliens in providing general cash public assistance
- § 1625. Authorization for verification of eligibility for State and local public benefits
